Research Disclosure offers a fast, effective way to publish and protect innovations. Each month we publish innovations covering all areas of science and technology. Submissions are published in the monthly Research Disclosure journal, online database and distributed globally to patent offices and public libraries. This establishes the published innovations as prior art which blocks others from patenting them.

How to submit a publication ?

Prepare the disclosure file

- MS Word or PDF
- File size A4 or US letter
- Margin of at least 1 inch, or 2.5cm
- Font size at least 12 point

Submit the disclosure

Upload your disclosure using the submission form at

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You will be prompted for the following details

Disclosure details

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- Disclosed by statement; either author names and any corporate affiliations or the statement Disclosed anonymously
- Language of the disclosure

Billing details

- Company name
- VAT number (EU companies only)
- Postal address (your copy of the journal and invoice will be sent here)

The publications process

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We extract searchable text from your submission and create a rasterized pdf version. That pdf is then sent back to you for approval prior to publication.

Disclosure finalised

Once we have received your final approval we will notify you of the paper journal's publication date and your disclosure will be date stamped and made available for online searching.

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Taking no action is risky

If you take no action or try keeping large numbers of innovations secret sooner or later someone else is going to patent your ideas. And when a third party obtains a patent on an invention you are using or might want to use in the future you are likely to have major problem.

A Research Disclosure publication gives cost effective protection by establishing the innovation as prior art which blocks others from patenting it.

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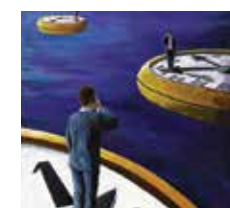
